**Museum Work at GGE Mandates More Space**

General Graphics Exhibits (GGE), San Francisco, has leased additional work space to accommodate the company's many recent wins in the museum exhibit industry. The new 8800 sq. ft. facility opened on April 1 and is near the current production facility in San Francisco.

Recently GGE announced that it had been selected to engineer, fabricate and install "Bill Nye's Climate Laboratory" at the Chabot Space & Science Center in Oakland, CA. In addition to this project, GGE is beginning work on several exhibits for the San Bernardino County natural history museum, which will highlight the pre-historic topology of the area.

GGE is also wrapping up fabrication on the White Point Nature Preserve Education Building, a project of the Palos Verdes Peninsula Land Conservancy. This installation traces the natural history of the area from prehistory through the first settlers up to recent efforts to rid the area of invasive species that threaten indigenous plants. The building is adjacent to the north side of the Port of Los Angeles and was formerly a Cold War military building used for the installation of nuclear warheads on Nike missiles.

Another project soon to begin is the West Basin Municipal Water District, where a sea lab is next to the West Basin Municipal Water District. The purpose of the sea lab is not only to showcase sea life in touch tanks but also to demonstrate desalination as a possible solution to California's impending water shortage. The lab will be a tool to sell politicians, scientist and environmentalists, as well as school kids, on the benefits of desalination and of conserving water.

"This is a huge leap for GGE," said Bill Nieser, one of the company Principals, "and one we feel especially good about because it connects us to our California identity in a meaningful way. We are very excited about our future."
